CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is First Nations Tax Administrators Association
2. The purposes of the society are:
 - a. to promote professional management of First Nation Taxation programmes and professional standards by the people responsible for the implementation and administration of First Nation taxation programmes;
 - b. to provide support for First Nation Taxation programmes and the people responsible for the implementation and administration of First Nation Taxation programmes;
 - c. to develop and provide educational programmes and materials for First Nation Taxation programmes and the people responsible for the implementation and administration of First Nation Taxation programmes;
 - d. to analyze and develop programmes, policies and procedures which will aid First Nations to develop and administer effective and efficient taxation and related revenue generating programmes;
 - e. to promote and support high standards of service and professionalism by First Nations taxation departments and programmes and administrative personnel;
 - f. to provide a central repository of information on First Nations Taxation matters for the use of First Nation Taxation programmes and the people responsible for the implementation and administration of First Nation Taxation programmes; ensuring the provision of education and career development programs;
 - g. promoting professional standards and ethics;
 - h. representing the First Nations Tax Administrators profession;
 - i. facilitating communication and information sharing among members and related agencies;
 - j. developing resource materials for First Nation Taxation operations; and
 - k. organizing an annual conference.
