SCALE

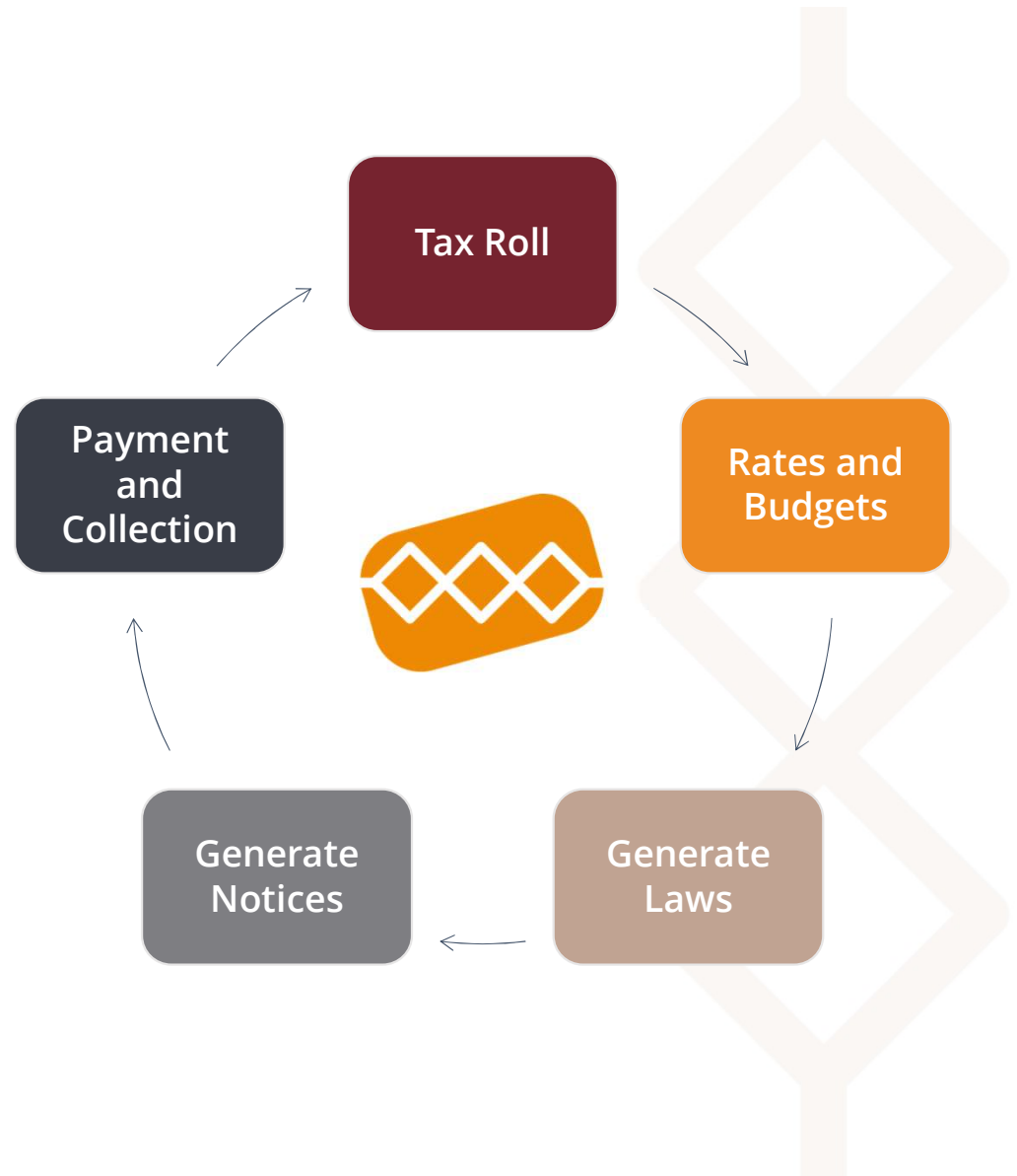
Currently serving First Nations with a few folios to more than 450

IMPORT


Seamlessly import assessment date

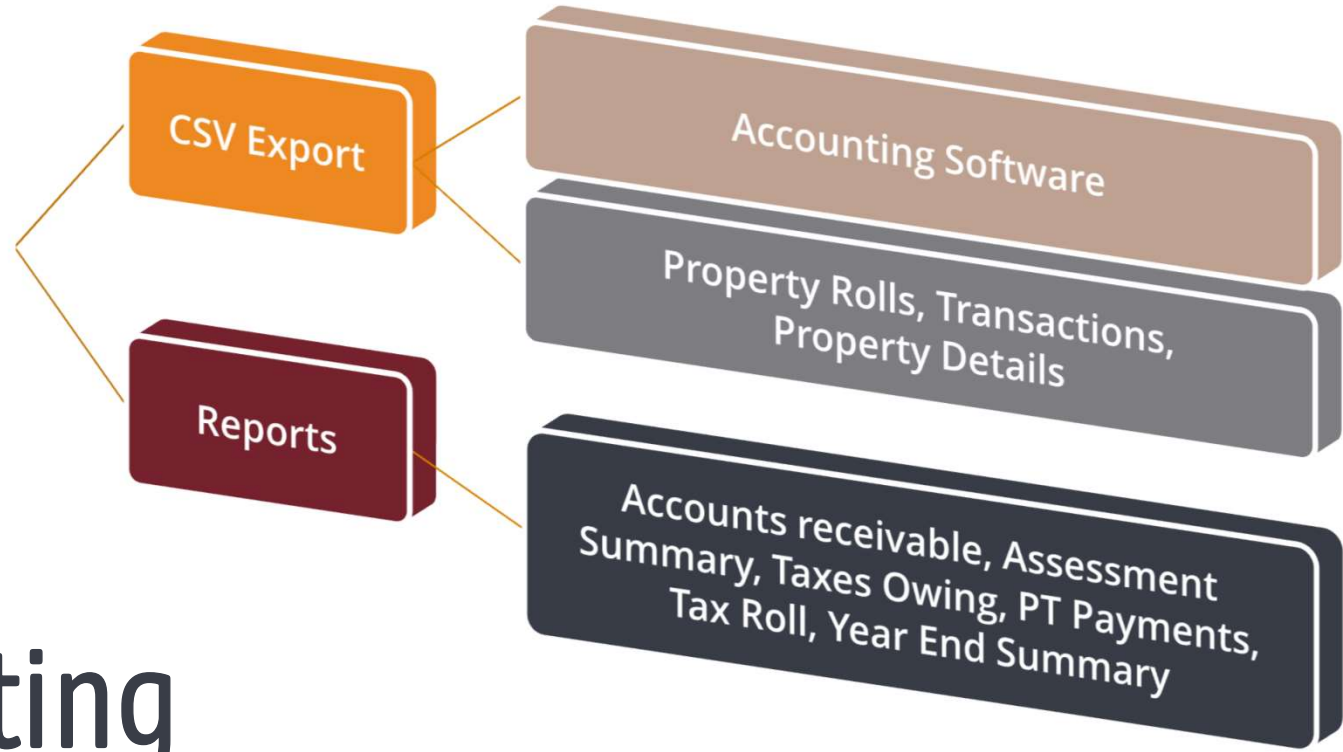

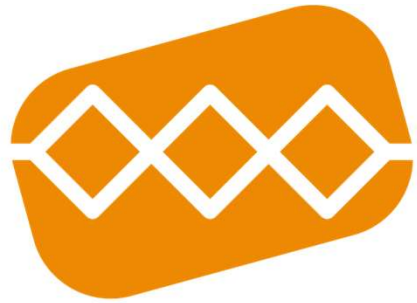

The Support System

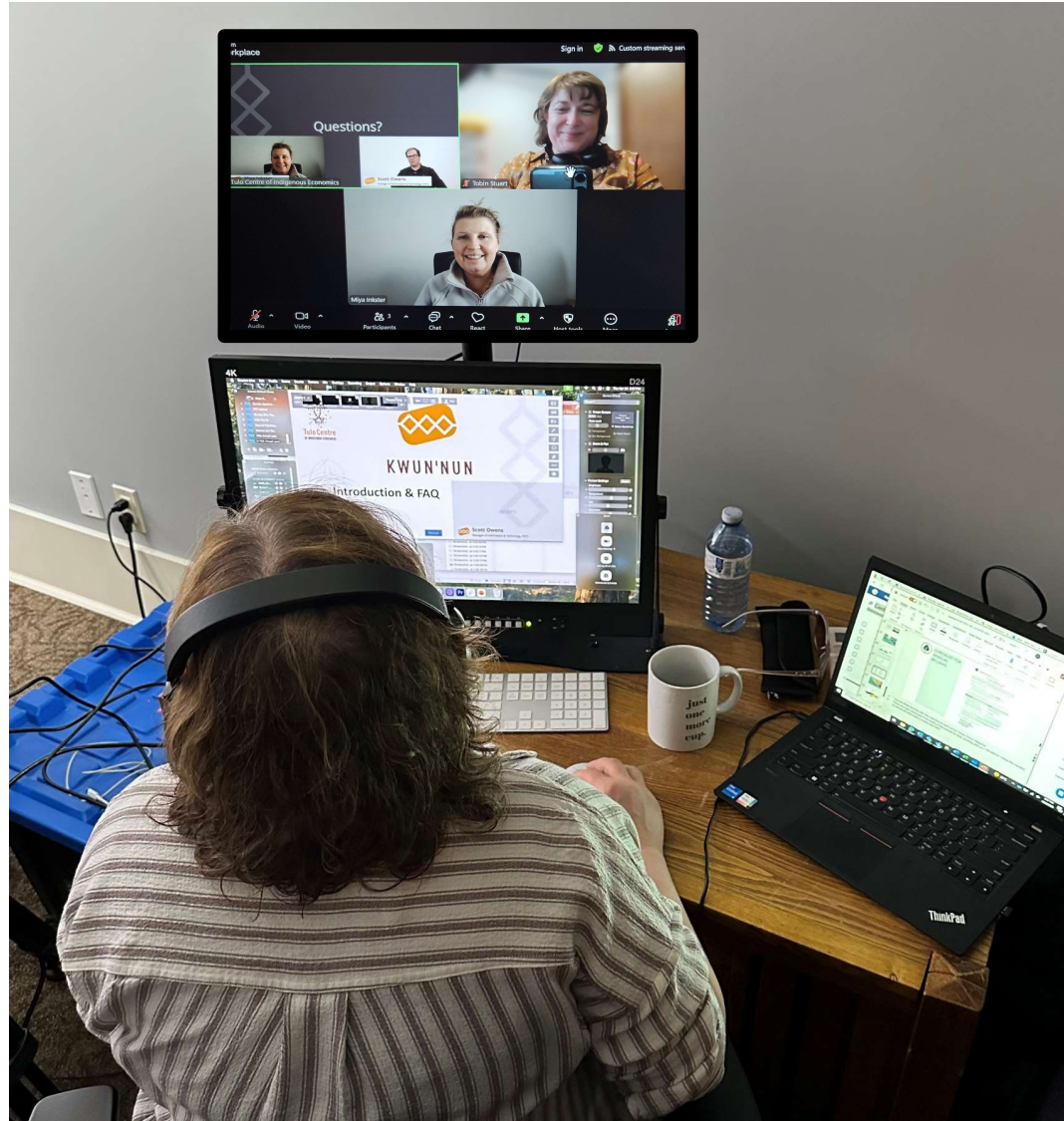


- **ONBOARDING:** Account set-up and data import support
